#### What is a Put-Together Rehearsal?

During our recital years, our faculty collaborates their dances and soloist characters to bring you a seamless story on stage. Every dancer at WEAD is part of this production. We hold put-together rehearsals at the studio to practice the flow of the show before bringing it to the stage. These rehearsals happen at WEAD. Dancers will NOT have regularly scheduled class during put-together week. **ALL dancers are asked to attend put together week. See schedule below.**

#### **Dress Rehearsals**

Dress rehearsals will be held May 28-30 at Deep Run High School.

All dancers are required to attend dress rehearsal and should arrive 30 minutes before your designated time. Please see full schedule on next page.

#### Complete hair, make-up, and costumes are required.

Have a seat with your class in the auditorium for dress rehearsals. Rows will be labeled with your class name. No food or drink is allowed in the auditorium. Once finished on-stage, dancers will be released by their instructors. Parents are welcome to stay and watch rehearsal, but we ask that talking be kept to a minimum. Please allow the front row of seats for faculty to conduct their rehearsals. All other seats are available during the rehearsal. We do our best to stay on time!

Please understand that sometimes rehearsals need a little extra time, but we always try our best to stay on schedule. Please do your best to be ready and on time to all rehearsals and performances.

#### Makeup and Hair for Recitals

Why do dancers wear stage makeup?

Stage makeup is necessary for all dancers. Once the house lights go down and the stage lights go up, without makeup, the audience will not be able to see the dancer's facial features. The stage lights wash out all skin tones. Accenting the eyes, lips, and cheeks with makeup will ensure you can see your dancer from any seat in the house. Up close, dancers may look silly with heavy makeup, but once on stage, we look completely normal.

# Full makeup and hair are encouraged for our dress rehearsals as a practice for the performance.

It is unsanitary to use other people's hair accessories and makeup.

### Hair for Ballet Dancers

All ballet dancers must wear their hair in a classical bun worn at the crown of the head. Please secure your bun with a hairnet and adequate bobby pins, hair spray, and hair elastic. Hair accessories should be worn on the right side of the bun (always secure with bobby pins).

Choreographers may ask soloists to do different hair styles for their role. Ask your choreographer if you aren't sure.

#### Hair for Non-Ballet Dancers

Hair should be pulled back off the face in a neat pony-tail at the crown of the head. No bangs and no "whispies" (use hair gel and hairspray). Try to slick your ponytail if you have thick hair, or curl it if you have thin hair. Please ask your teacher for advice on how to wear your hair for their dance.

#### Costumes

Costumes will be handed out in class and sent home beginning April 15th. Your account must have a zero balance in order for the costume(s) to be sent home.

- If your child has more than one dance they will be required to wear a nude or skin colored camisole/leotard as an undergarment to the performance and dress rehearsal.
- Costumes are custom made and cannot be replaced if lost or damaged. Please do not allow your dancer to play in the costume until after his or her final performance.
- If there are any problems with your child's costume, please notify the studio immediately. 804-740-0842.
- You may remove your costume from the bag and hang it up in a steam filled bathroom to remove any wrinkles.
- If your child has a quick change, all costume pieces should be on hangers and clearly labeled with name of child and dance.

# Please put your child's name on everything to ensure that all items come back home with them after the show.

### Photographs

Everyone should arrive to their regular class time for picture week, unless otherwise noted below. All dancers please report to the grey studio **in costume**. No parents allowed in the brown studio while photos are being taken.

## If you wish to purchase solo or class shots, please complete the attached form and return with payment on picture day. If you have a lead part in the show and would like to purchase a solo photo, please sign up in advance in the office.

- Monday 3:15pm Pre-Ballet with Miss Patty same class start time, but you will stay late as pictures begin at 4:15pm. Dancers will wait in the grey studio (supervised) until pictures begin in the brown studio and will be released after their picture has been taken.
- Tuesday 12:45pm Pre-ballet with Miss Nadine you will still have class at 12:45pm. Come for pictures only at 4:15pm that day.
- Saturday 10:00am Ballet I/II with Miss Julia you will still have class on Saturday. Come for pictures only at 4:15pm on Friday, May 17.
- Saturday 10:00am Pre-ballet with Miss Nadine you will still have class on Saturday. Come for pictures only at 4:30pm on Friday, May 17th.
- Saturday 11:00am Ballet III with Miss Julia you will still have class on Saturday. Come for pictures only at 5:00pm on Friday, May 17th.

#### **Parent Volunteers**

### **Ticket Sales**

Tickets will be available to purchase online through the West End Academy of Dance website. General ticket sales will open to the rest of the school online on April 15, 2019.

There is no limit to the number of tickets that can be purchased, and tickets are sold on a first come first served basis. Please note, tickets are non-refundable.

Tickets are \$15 for adults (18 and older) and \$12 for children (17 and under) and seniors (65 and older). Tickets will also be available for purchase at the door.
